**Report for 2013-2018.**

• *Society Activities*

The main aim of the Society is to strengthen scientific interaction between professionals working with plant diseases and pests in Denmark. The Danish Society is managed by a board which meet 2-3 times a year. It consists of a president, a treasurer, secretary plus 4 members and two substitute members.

The Society organizes every year 4- 5 activities for the members. Typically it is visits and guided tours at relevant companies and institutes, plant nurseries and breeding stations. In addition, we annually hold a general assembly and a photo evening where the main purpose is to tell a story using nice photos of diseases and pests.

The Society is responsible for naming plant diseases and pests in agriculture, horticulture and forestry. Two nomenclature committees – one for diseases and one for pests - suggest names and they are then approved at an annual general assembly.
