The French Society of Phytopathology (Société Française de Phytopathologie – SFP) is a non-profit society aimed at encouraging and developing research in phytopathology, facilitating relationships between scientists, and participating in the organization of national and international congresses, conferences and meetings.

The SFP financially encourages young scientists (PhD students) to attend national and international conferences related to phytopathology, by awarding about 10 grants (of 400 to 1000€) each year.

The Society holds its national congress every 3 years. The last SFP Congress was held in Paris in June 2012, and the forthcoming SFP Congress will be held in Colmar in June 2015. The SFP also organizes three more specific conferences (focused on plant virology, bacteriology and mycology) in Aussois (French Alps) every 2 years (see below). These meetings include a prize for the best oral presentation and the best poster presented by a student.

The SFP also sponsors a number of national and international conferences, related to plant pathology, which are organized by SFP members.

Communication among SFP members is largely provided through a mailing list (about 400 messages posted each year) and the SFP Website (<http://www.sfp-asso.org/>)

The SFP board has decided to contribute, together with Philippe Lepoivre (Gembloux, Belgium) to a new edition of his famous French-speaking “Phytopathologie” book dating 2003 (http://superieur.deboeck.com/titres/27113_/phytopathologie.html).
