The historic center of Madrid is also known as Madrid de los Austrias (Habsburgs), the dynasty that reigned in Spain until 1700. This reign began with Carlos I, who enriched the city with palaces and monuments. This was accentuated when Philip II moved the seat of the court from Toledo to Madrid, making it the capital of the kingdom of Spain until now. The tour of the Renaissance and Baroque buildings of this period is perhaps one of the most picturesque and representative of Madrid and includes places as representative as the Plaza de Oriente where the Royal Palace is located, the Calle Mayor, the Plaza de la Villa (old City Hall) and its surroundings.
