The main goal of SBF is to promote Plant Pathology in Brazil. A new website with more content was launched to be more resourceful to plant pathologists, mainly those working on remote areas in Brazil, far from consolidated research groups and facilities.

SBF sponsors two journals: Tropical Plant Pathology, which publishes scientific articles (in English only) in all fields of interest, as well as in all sorts of crops. The other journal is known as Revisão Anual de Patologia de Plantas (Annual Review of Plant Pathology) that publishes review articles in either Portuguese or in English.
