Report for 2013-2018

Society Activities and publications

The French Society of Phytopathology (Société Française de Phytopathologie – SFP) is a non-profit society aimed at encouraging and developing research in phytopathology, facilitating relationships between scientists, and participating in the organization of national and international congresses, conferences and meetings. The SFP financially encourages young scientists (PhD students) to attend national and international conferences related to phytopathology, by awarding about 10 grants each year. The Society holds its national congress every 3 years. The last Congress was a joined conference SFP with the European Foundation for Plant Pathology (EFPP), which was held in Dunkerque in June 2017.

The forthcoming SFP Congress will be held in Bordeaux or Arcachon in June 2021. Members of SFP were selected by ISPP to organize the ICPP2023 Congress which will be held in Lyon (France) from 20-25 August 2023 and thus be hosted by the SFP.

The SFP also organizes three more specific conferences (focused on plant virology, bacteriology and mycology) in Aussois (French Alps) every 2 years (see below). During these meeting, the SFP awards a prize for the best oral presentation and the best poster presented by the students. The SFP also sponsors a number of national and international conferences, related to plant pathology, which are organized by SFP members. Communication among SFP members is largely provided through a mailing list (about 300 messages posted each year), the SFP Website (http://www.sfp-asso.org/), and a Twitter account since 2016 (@SFP_France, >850 followers, >2000 tweets). The SFP board has decided

to contribute to a new edition of his famous French-speaking "Phytopathologie" book dating 2003. The second edition might be produced in 2019.
