Report for 2009-2013.

Society Activities and publications. A brief background, and information about the aims and achievements of the MPU is given in the society website, with links to the journal published by MPU, to the MPU Newsletter and links to MPU activities.

The Society publishes in print and on-line, an international plant pathology journal, *Phytopathologia Mediterranea* (www.fupress.com/pm/). A lot of efforts in the Union has been recently devoted to promoting the journal and improving its quality and impact on the scietific community. The on-line edition improved a lot the access and indexing of the journal. The jornal is also under inclusion within the Jstore database.

Plant Pathology in the Mediterranean Area.

The MPU journal devotes special attention and space to the role of Plant Protection in food health. In this frame it published in 2012 a Special issue dedicated to "Mycotoxin risks in Mediterranean countries".

It also devotes a special attention to diseases of one of the more typical crops in the area, grapevine. This is reflected in the coorganization of Workshops by MPU in collaboration with the SMC on Grapevine Trunk Diseases, and in the publication of 8 Special issues on the subject.

A Special issue was also dedicated in 2013 to Pulse crops, another very relevant crop for the Mediterranean area. The next Special issue now in preparation will be devoted to the Future developments in Integrated Pest Management (2014)
