Report for 2013-2018.

- Society activities and publications. The Society organizes Congresses, Meetings, Summer Schools and Workshops, collects and spreads information related to plant diseases, keeps connections with other National and International Scientific Organizations as well as with technical bodies at Ministerial and Regional level, as well as with other Agencies on issues related to plant diseases. SIPaV is affiliated to: International Society for Plant Pathology (ISPP), European Foundation for Plant Pathology (EFPP), Mediterranean Phytopathological Union (MPU), Italian Association of Agricultural Scientific Societies (AISSA), and Italian Federation of Life Sciences (FISV). In October 2017, SIPaV signed a Memorandum of Understanding with the American Phytopathological Society (APS) in order to facilitate mutually beneficial interactions through scientific exchanges and professional interactions.  - The *Journal of Plant Pathology* (JPP) is the international journal of SIPaV. Since 2018, the JPP has been published by Springer. The aim of JPP is to publish results of research on fundamental and applied aspects of plant pathology. All contributions are peer reviewed under the supervision of an international Editorial Board. - Society Conferences and Workshops. 2013-2018. SIPaV organizes the annual National Congress: XIX National Congress of SIPaV University of Padova (September 23rd-25th, 2013), XX National Congress of SIPaV University of Pisa (September 22rd-24th, 2014), XXI National Congress of SIPaV University of Torino (September 21st-23rd, 2015), XXII National Congress of SIPaV Council for Agricultural Research and Agricultural Economy Analysis (CREA) and "Sapienza" University of Roma (September 19th-22rd, 2016), XXIII National Congress of SIPaV Università Cattolica del Sacro Cuore (Piacenza) (October 4th-6th, 2017), and XXIV National Congress of SIPaV University of Ancona (September 5th-7th, 2018). In this last edition, a joint session SIPaV-APS on "Emerging and re-emerging plant pathogens" will be organised.

- Funding opportunities. SIPaV supports the young Members with different funding opportunities:
 - ✓ annual SIPaV "Scaramuzzi Prize" for the best PhD work in plant pathology (1000 €);
 - ✓ annual SIPaV "Giovani in formazione Grant" for the participation at the annual National Congress of the Society (20 grants consisting in the free registration to the SIPaV Congress, free membership subscription to the Society and online access to the Journal of Plant Pathology for three years);
 - ✓ grants for the presentation of scientific works at national and international congresses (e.g., ICPP 2018, International Congress of Plant Pathology 3 grants of 750 € each; XV Congress of the Italian Federation of Life Sciences, FISV 2018 5 grants of 100 € each);
 - ✓ grants for Master Thesis abroad in the field of Plant Pathology (2017: 3 grants of 250 € each; 2018: 3 grants of 350 € each).

In 2018, SIPaV establishes for the first time the prize "Insegnami a curare una pianta" addressed to secondary schools in order to stimulate students' curiosity for the plant pathology field through innovative and creative initiatives.
